God of every time and place, in Jesus' name and filled with your Holy Spirit, we entrust these spoken prayers and those in our hearts into your holy keeping. **Amen**

And also with you.

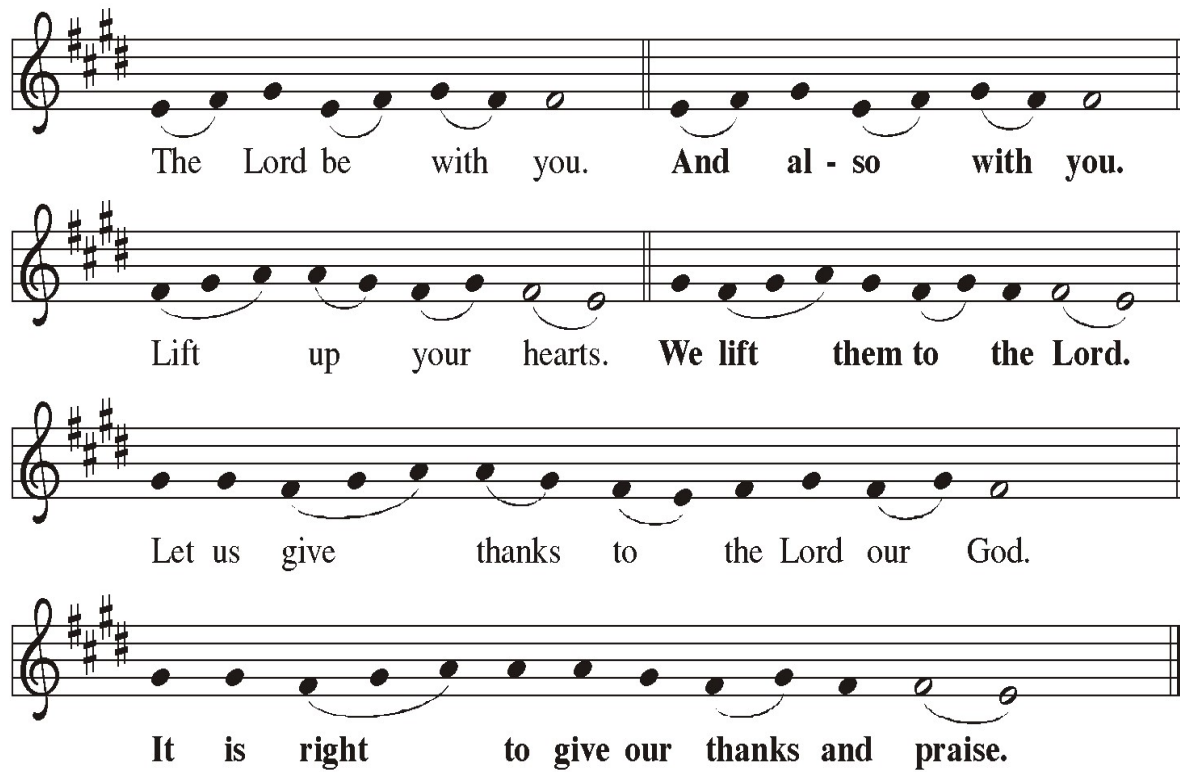
MEAL

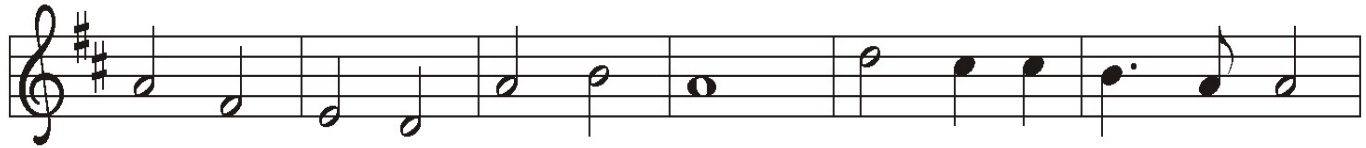


*PREFACE

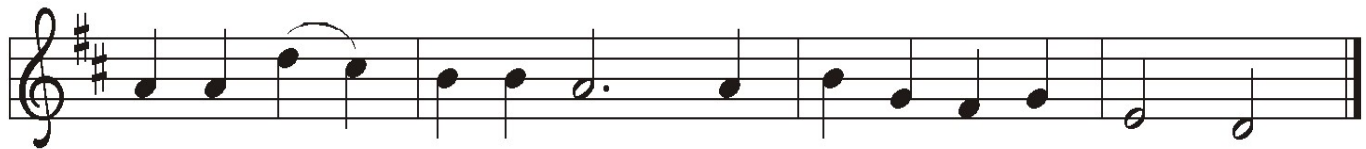

SENDING

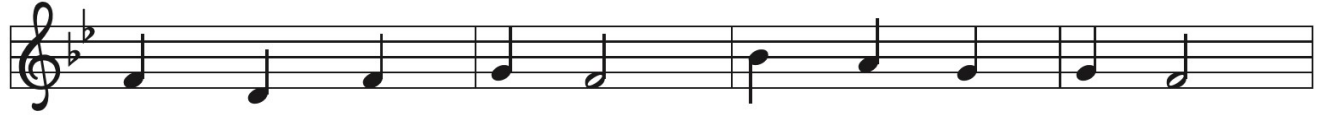
God blesses us and sends us in mission to the world.

and fill you with courage. **Amen**



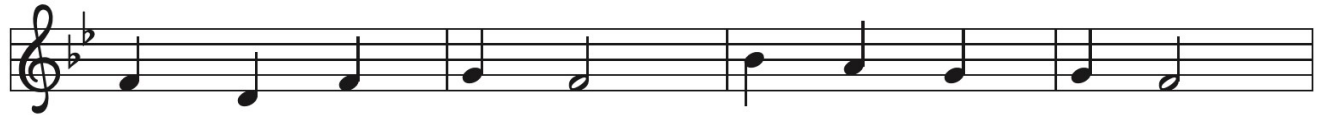
